1. Introduction

The CE upholds the responsibility to extend and safeguard the confidentiality and execution of all the examinations together with the spirit of the College. The CE follows the manual approved by the Governing Council of the College for the conduct of examinations.

The office of the CE prepares the schedule for all the examinations and publish it with the consent of the Principal. The syllabi of various courses are collected from the departments after the approval of the respective Boards of studies, file them and keep them for the use for end semester examinations.

Information to be intimated to the students are sent on web by the office of CE and this enables the candidates to know the exact date and time of examinations and their due appearance is guaranteed too. Candidates can apply for and pay the examination fees online using the college website and can have their own hall tickets downloaded that might have been automatically generated.
